Minutes from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 11th June 2018 at Burgh Castle Village Hall

PUBLIC SECTION

-It was reported an overgrown bush located on Lords Lane past Burgh Hall on the left hand side is very overgrown, and now has had a bollard placed in front of it. It was agreed for this to be reported to the Highways Dept.
